

ORDINANCE NO. 94- 20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING OKALOOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 84-38, WHICH CREATED THE HOLT FIRE DISTRICT; INCREASING THE MAXIMUM ASSESSMENT WHICH MAY BE IMPOSED FOR SERVICES; PROVIDING A PROCEDURE FOR ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PROVISIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKALOOSA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Subsection 1 of Section 8 of Okaloosa County Ordinance No. 84-38, the Holt Fire District Ordinance, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) The Board of Fire Commissioners is hereby authorized to levy and impose an annual assessment or service charge against all property in the District in an amount adequate to fund the operations of the district, and shall advertise and conduct all public hearings necessary for the imposition of the same in the manner required by Florida Statutes prior to adoption of the Resolution hereinbelow specified in Subsection (2)."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the Department of State of the State of Florida that it has been filed and does hereby repeal all Ordinances or provisions

thereof in conflict herewith.
